Utah Certified Backflow Testers

Under Utah State drinking water rules (R309-105. Administration: General Responsibilities of Public Water Systems) water suppliers are responsible to maintain a functioning cross connection control program. As part of that program it is required that all backflow prevention assemblies shall be tested annually. The following Utah certified backflow technicians have tested backflow prevention assemblies connected to the Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District public drinking water system. This list is not an endorsement by Jordan Valley Water as to their qualifications, but is provided as a reference only. Any Class 2 or Class 3 backflow technician certified by the Utah Division of Drinking Water may provide testing of backflow prevention assemblies.
