Summary: This project is the first major element of the expansion of the JWVWTP. The plate settler equipment will be installed in sedimentation basins 3-6 in coordination with the replacement of the solids collection equipment in those basins. This contract will provide both the new plate settlers as well as mounting equipment for the chain and flight sedimentation equipment purchased previously.

Staff utilized a competitive proposal procurement process for this project to consider relevant factors (e.g. price, successful experience with similar applications, equipment details and features, and required maintenance). A proposal evaluation committee scored the proposals using criteria defined in the proposal documents and determined that the MRI proposal provides the most valuable combination of price and technical performance.

This project will have staged deliveries starting in October 2022 and extending until January 2024.
