# Landscape Improvements – 108 East 11400 South Project #4079 April 2019

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** This project consists of landscape improvements for a pump station site by replacing areas of existing turf with waterwise landscaping. The work will include site grubbing, concrete work, landscaping, and irrigation system installation as indicated on the Project Drawings.

**PROJECT SCHEDULE:** The work shall be completed within 180 calendar days from the date of acceptance of the Award of Purchase Order. If the work is not completed within the specified time frame, the bidder herein agrees to accept liquidated damages in the amount of \$200 per day.

**RECEIPT OF BIDS:** Sealed bids will be received by Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District, attention Kevin Rubow at the Administration Building located at 8215 South 1300 West, West Jordan, Utah 84088, until **3:00 pm, Thursday, April 25, 2019**.

**OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:** The Contract Documents are entitled: "Landscape Improvements – 108 East 11400 South". All Contract Documents may be obtained on the District's website (<a href="www.jvwcd.org">www.jvwcd.org</a>) beginning. Prospective bidders must register at the District's web site under the project to receive project notifications and addenda, if any. Contractors are required to check the District's web site for any addenda prior to submitting a responsive bid. Bids determined to be non-responsive may be rejected.

### **Project Requirements:**

The work to be performed under this project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary or required to complete the work in all respects as shown on the Drawings and as herein specified. All work, materials, and services not expressly shown or called for in the Contract Documents which may be necessary to complete the construction of the work in good faith shall be performed, furnished, and installed by Contractor as though originally so specified or shown, at no increase in cost to Owner.

Project specifications are included on the Project Drawings and as herein specified. Contractor is required to provide all necessary City construction permits as required to complete the work at its cost. Contractor is responsible to keep the work site in a clean and safe condition while completing the work. The Contractor shall comply with its written safety policy for all work which shall include air-quality testing and use of personal protective equipment. Sanitary equipment, including one portable toilet, shall

be provided by the Contractor for the duration of the work. Contractor shall keep existing facilities accessible to the Owner at all times, for the duration of the work.

Payment shall be made by the Owner upon monthly submittal of a PAYMENT APPLICATION AND CERTIFICATE (included). Payment will be made within 30 days of approval of work completed by the project manager. Change Orders (if any), will be per the District's standard form (included). Substantial Completion and Final Completion certificates (included) shall be presented by the contractor to the Owner's Project Manager for approval.

### **Project Specifications:**

### 1.1 Irrigation System

- A. The irrigation system will be constructed using the irrigation, valves, piping, fittings, controllers, wiring, nozzles, etc., of sizes specified.
- B. Irrigation lines shown on the drawings are essentially diagrammatic.
- C. As-built Irrigation Drawings: Contractor shall prepare as-built drawings which shall show deviations from the contract documents made during construction affecting the main line pipe, controller locations, remote control valves, and manual drain valves. These shall be kept on a clean set of prints of the contract drawings.
- D. The work consists of furnishing and installing an underground irrigation system as shown on the drawings and specifications. Include all labor, equipment and materials and perform all operations in connection with the construction of the irrigation systems.
- E. Electrical Wire: Control wire shall be rated for direct burial and shall be continuous with no splices. Provide, at minimum, 2 spare wires from the farthest valve to the controller and label as such.
- F. Guarantee: All work shall be guaranteed for compliance with the drawings and specifications for a period of one year after the date of final completion. The Contractor shall make good any deficiencies at the time he is notified of any faults.

# 1.2 Landscape

- A. The extent of the landscape development work is shown on the drawings and includes soil amendments, preparation of landscaped areas, steel edging, concrete work, placement of all plant materials, stone mulch, and maintenance and guarantee.
- B. The Contractor will keep a record of all departures from the contract drawings that occur during construction. These shall be kept on a clean set of prints of the contract drawings.

- C. Provide trees grown in a recognized nursery in accordance with good horticultural practice. Provide healthy, vigorous stock grown under climatic conditions similar to the locality of the project and free of disease, insects, eggs, larvae, and defects such as knots, sun-scale, injuries, abrasions, or disfigurement.
- D. Plant materials and other landscape items will be evaluated according to compliance with drawings, schedules, and specifications; as well as overall aesthetic quality, grower or supplier reputation, physical inspection, and American Association of Nurseryman Standards (ANSI Z60.1).
- E. Deliver plants after preparations for planting have been completed and plant immediately. If planting is delayed more than 6 hours after delivery, set plants in shade, protect from weather and mechanical damage, and keep roots moist.
- F. Weed control is required. The extent of control depends on the type, quantity, and stage of weeds. The following are methods that may be used to control weeds: herbicide, post-emergent, or mechanical as required to completely eradicate undesired vegetation. Apply herbicide so no damage to protected vegetation occurs whether inside or outside of the project site. Use a Utah State Licensed applicator to apply herbicide.
- G. Guarantee plant material for one year following final completion against defects including death and unsatisfactory growth, except for defects resulting from lack of adequate maintenance, neglect, or abuse by Owner, abnormal weather conditions unusual for warranty period, or incidents that are beyond Contractor's control. Remove and replace plant material found to be unacceptable. Replacements shall be made during the growing season.
